

**01/23/2023****TSCA Material Declaration**

U.S. Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) addresses the production, importation, use, and disposal of certain chemicals into or within the United States and provides the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) with the authority to require reporting, record-keeping, and restrictions relating to chemical substances and/or mixtures. The goal of TSCA is to prevent or reduce health risks and environmental pollution.

The Lee Company EFS Division does not manufacture, import, process, use, or commercially distribute any of the nine restricted substance families including:

- Asbestos
- Lead (in paint)
- PCBs (Polychlorinated Biphenyls)
- Dioxins
- Chlorofluorocarbons
- Mercury
- Formaldehyde
- Nitrites
- Hexavalent Chromium Compounds

Additionally, The Lee Company EFS Division does not manufacture, import, process, use, or commercially distribute any of the five PBT chemicals identified by the EPA Final Rules on January 6, 2021, under Section 6(h) of TSCA Section 18 which include:

- Decabromodiphenyl ether (DecaBDE)
- Phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1) (PIP (3:1))
- 2,4,6-Tris(tert-butyl)phenol (2,4,6-TTBP)
- Hexachlorobutadiene (HCBD)
- Pentachlorothiophenol (PCTP)

This declaration is applicable to all The Lee Company, EFS Division Products.

As we continue to perform our due diligence with material compliance inquiries with our suppliers, if we subsequently discover otherwise, we will inform affected customers.
